The USS Yorktown was the tenth aircraft carrier to serve in the United States Navy. Sign up at the front desk to take a private tour of the USS Yorktown on Tuesday at 10 AM. Meet in the lobby at 9:45am to pick up your tickets and walk over together. Tickets are \$14 for adults and \$7 for children under 12.

Tuesday– Trivia Night

All trivia gurus meet us in the Charleston Harbor Reel Bar every Tuesday night from 6-8pm for free Trivia Night! Enjoy trivia questions from all categories and for all ages. Happy hour specials from 5-8pm.

Wednesday– Boone Hall Plantation

Boone Hall Plantation is one of America's oldest working, living plantations. The trip is from 11am-3pm and includes house tours, exploring the Gullah culture, slave street and history presentation, plantation coach tour, garden tour, and a butterfly pavilion.

The Charleston Harbor Resort and Marina will provide the Trolley ride to and from Boone Hall Plantation. The cost is \$15 for adults and \$7 for children (5 and under are free).

Thursday– Sunset Cruise

Join us for a Sunset Harbor Cruise aboard the Charleston Explorer. This cruise is sure to amaze you with views of Charleston from the Harbor and sights of dolphin swimming right next to the boat. Meet in the Reel Bar at 6:15 PM to enjoy live music, grab a drink, and walk to the dock together. The cruise is from 6:30-8pm and is \$17 for adults and \$12 for children. Light snacks are provided in addition to a variety of wine and beer featured weekly. There is a 10 person minimum to set sail.

Friday– Kayak Tour

Join us for a 1/2 day Kayak Tour with Coastal Expeditions. This tour is for beginners as well as experienced kayakers. Paddle the salt marsh creek past Mt. Pleasant's scenic fleet of shrimp boats. This tour is sure to amaze you with views of Charleston from the Harbor and sights of dolphin swimming right next to your kayak. Meet in the lobby at 8:50 AM to ride the Trolley to Shem Creek. The tour is from 9-12:30pm and is \$59 for adults and \$39 for children. Please sign up at the front desk by 5pm on Thursday. There is a 2 person minimum and 12 person maximum to kayak.

Friday– Movie Mania

Calling all kids! Mini Mariners Movie Mania has begun! Meet us in the Harbor Room this and every Friday night from 6-9pm. Children 5-12 Welcome! The cost is \$10 for resort guests and \$15 for non resort guests and includes pizza, drinks, crafts, games, popcorn, and a movie!

Saturday– Kids Camp

All Mini Mariners (children 5-12) are welcome to join us for an entire day of fun! We will be exploring the local nature trails, playing at the Mt. Pleasant pier, and doing fun activities around the hotel such as tie dying T-shirts, sand castle contests, games, and harbor activities. Camp will be held every Saturday. Resort Offers 2 Ways to Get to Charleston

Ollie the Big Blue Trolley has arrived at the Charleston Harbor Resort and Marina. All aboard to downtown Charleston via the scenic Arthur Ravenel Bridge. Ollie is an authentic trolley that seats up to 14 passengers and leaves 7 days a week on the even hour between 10am and 10pm heading to historic downtown Charleston and back. He will also be making 3 round trip rides to Sullivan's Island that leave the hotel at 9am, 1pm, and 5pm. To reserve a seat on Ollie the Big Blue Trolley, please contact the front desk.



Don't miss the boat! Catch the Charleston Water Taxi, the ultimate ride to the best places on the Charleston Harbor.



You can relax and enjoy the picturesque views of the new Ravenel Bridge while the dolphins and pelicans feed alongside the boat. The water taxi leaves from the Marina every hour on the hour and returns at the bottom of the hour from 10am to 6pm. The cost is \$5 one way and \$8 both ways. Children 5 and under are free. The water taxi was voted Charleston's cheapest sunset cruise voted by the Charleston City Paper.



Hop on Ollie the Trolley every morning at 8 AM for a little exercise. Ollie will be making a drop off at the foot of the Ravenel Bridge (Tues, Thurs, Sat, and Sun) or the Nature Trail (Mon, Wed, Fri). See the front desk for a map of the nature trail.

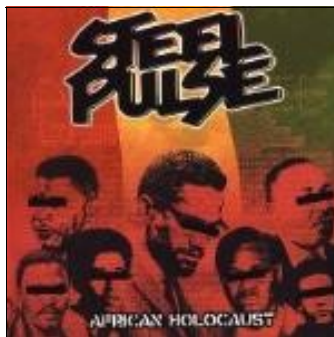
Ride through historic Old Village in Mount Pleasant or hop on the Water Taxi and peddle around downtown. See Front Desk for more information.
