The SIGNATURE: How to Host the Perfect Southern Party

Suzanne Pollak, the Dean of The Charleston Academy of Domestic Pursuits knows how to throw a good party. She should. She's been hosting soirces for big personalities, dignitaries and giant corporations at her historic homes in South Carolina for the past 30 years. And, this southern hospitality expert has published three books on the topic.

In this class, guests will discover the art of: -Welcoming Guests to the Party -How to Invite the Mayor (or other dignitary) to an Event (and what to say when they show up) -When to Leave Guests to Tend to the Kitchen -How to Keep the Party OUT of the Kitchen -How to Hold a Wine Glass and other Etiquette Essentials -Invoking Conversations When There is None -Informing Guests that the Party is Over (with Southern Grace of course) -And any other topic the participants are curious about, including How to Roast a Pig. Sessions with Dean Pollak take place at The Beach Club at Charleston Harbor Resort & Marina in the private movie theater or other meeting space suited to the event. The resort can help make it even more magical by booking the session on a private yacht or on the beach, overlooking the harbor. Special accommodations can also be made to host in an historic home in downtown Charleston.

Parties from 2 to 100 can book the hour-long Perfect Southern Party session or chose from a more comprehensive hospitality immersion, below:

Hands-On Classic Charleston Cooking (2.5 Hours)

Class begins with a cocktail demo. (plus generous sampling) and moves into a hand-on recipe tutorial and cooking class. Then we sit down for a meal and discussion of all things cooking/entertaining/etiquette-related. Participants receive a signed copy of the Academy Handbook. A sample menu might start with an Old Fashioned and include local fare such as flaky cheese biscuits, sautéed South Carolina peaches, shrimp & grits, and bourbon coconut pie for dessert. Perfect for a couple looking for an intimate, Southern-made Charleston experience.

How to Throw a Cocktail Party: (2.5 Hours)

Menu prep includes low-maintenance, high-impact cocktail snacks, punches, pitchers, and even bespoke ice cubes. We will cover tried and true tips plus new ideas to host the most talked about cocktail parties in town. (After all, that is what a cocktail hour should do ~ get people buzzing!) Q&A includes guest lists, pacing, cocktails, wine, food, bars, dress, introductions, how to wrap it up, what to do when you are the guest, and how to graciously handle accidents. Depending on the season, snacks may range from hot oysters wrapped in bacon, cold carrot vichyssoise, pre-made ham biscuits or last-minute fried zucchini.

Hosting Brunch or Lunch: (2.5 Hours)

Brunches are a weekend staple all over the country. We teach students how to plan, how to set up, what to serve, how to dress, whom to invite, and how to make the occasion both relaxing and memorable. Best for business, holidays, or even bachelor parties, the ancient customs and contemporary ways of luncheon gatherings should be revived according to the host's personal style.

The Art of the Perfect Wedding

Dean Pollak hosts either a luncheon or cocktail party at a Beach Club venue for bridal parties (including brides, their mothers, maids of honor, and bachelorettes) with instructions on how build a registry that works, finding the right wedding planner, and fashion/etiquette advice ranging from choosing bridesmaid dresses to making a seating chart.
